<b>July 20<sup>th</sup></b>	Would 2 or 3 members volunteer to help Lynn at the <b>Moel Fammau Children's Activity Day</b> , from 10 till - yes, unfortunately it does clash with the Guild meeting. Anyone who wants to go, please take your own chair, and, if possible, things for children to have a go at. If you can only do a morning or afternoon, that's fine. It's in the lower carpark, where the toilets are. There's usually a van selling food.

<b>Aug. 4<sup>th</sup></b> May Sandra have names please?	<b>Bryneglwys Show</b> - on a field to the left of the A5104 if you are coming from the Chester/Wrexham/Llandegla direction. Postcode for google is LL21 9NG. Can you be there by 12 please. You shouldn't need to pay if you say you are with the guild and ask to be allowed to drive to the right, onto the showground. The organisers will usually let you drive over to whichever tent they provide (it won't be the really big one this year) and I usually leave my car behind the tent until I leave, but there is a car park in the next field, to the left as you enter the showground. It finishes around 4pm ish. Bring a chair. Sandwiches, cakes and drinks available to buy on the showground.
<b>Aug. 10<sup>th</sup></b> May Sandra have names please?	<b>Llanarmon yn Ial Show</b> . The Park, Gelli Gynan Hall, Llanarmon yn Ial, CH7 4QX. Show starts at 10am but please be there well before to set up. You are allowed to drive to the tent provided and there is parking not far behind the tent. The Show finishes around 4 to 4.30. You are not expected to pay to go in, please say you are with the Guild. Cakes, drinks and a BBQ are available to buy on the showground. Please bring a chair, also a small table if you wish to use pegloom etc.

Take a chair, just in case there aren't enough. I think you will then have to move your cars to the carpark. The Show finishes around 4-4.30 ish. Refreshments available to buy on the showground.

There is a small carpark opposite the village hall and a tiny one on the showground, so, the earlier the better if you want a good parking place. There is usually a cake and drinks tent. For new members, all the welsh guilds have an open day every year with displays and talks. Each guild has space for a display of their work plus we are given a theme and asked to put together an A0 sized board on this theme using "Weaving, Spinning and Dyeing". Note this means that felting or knitting can only be included if you have dyed the fibre (felting) or spun and/or dyed the knitting yarn.

This year's theme is "Patterns of Wales".

Gillian is hoping we can provided pieces to make up a map of our area.

We need volunteers to provide pieces to make up the map. Can everyone try really hard to contribute this year :-)

If we could get just one small (eg around A5) piece from each of you .... and some pieces of braid or inkle, there would be more than enough. Ps the piece doesn't have to be a rectangle

- sea blues
- castle area
- hills greeny purple
- town areas

And then some of the weavers could make a sand coloured stripe that can be applied over the top to form the coast, and a thin grey stripes to make the roads When its all together we could add maybe sheep to the hills and seagull and boats to the sea. The map could do with being bigger( nearer) more detailed.

If you have any offcuts or spar pieces of weaving that meet the colours required, or perhaps dyed fleece or wool that you or someone else could knit or felt, can you bring them along his Saturday and think about doing something to help over the summer.
