Mar 18 Lofty Spinning and knitting with beads with Freyalynn (Booking required)

Jane writes that for a full weekend course, the requirements were: "spinning wheel; spindle; assorted fibre (both washed fleece and prepared tops); carders and combs if you have them; any yarns you already have that you'd like to try with beads; range of knitting needles; large-eyed darning needle; ordinary sewing needles and sewing thread; beads (my favourite are 2, 3 and 5mm seed beads, but I'll use all sorts. The main proviso is a reasonably sized hole for the yarn to go through). An ability to spin and knit - but not necessarily to any great level of expertise. The intention is to play with ideas and have fun. I shall bring various fibres and beads for people to have a go with. If you do use my stuff, a small contribution will be welcome." For our shorter day course, we probably will need to limit the range of fibres and knitting techniques.
