<b>March 16<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Wavy Weaving with B. Weir (Paid workshop). See Below</b>
<b>April 10<sup>th</sup></b>	<b>Abergele Guild Friendship Day.</b> From 10-4 pm. We are hosting the Welsh Rep ( Heather Beckett) from the AWSD National committee on this day. Our day takes place at Betws yn Rhos Village hall on the B5381. It's only 3 miles from the main coast road from Abergele. We will have trade stands, sales tables and demonstrations throughout the day including weavers, dyers and fibre producers. Refreshments will be available all day.

#### Wavy Weaving with B. Weir

For those signed up for the workshop, Bee Weir has sent a rough list of what is needed.. The end piece could be a wall hanging or be used as part of a scarf. Looms should be warped up using 7-10dpi heddles. About 60-90cm plus waste, as an estimate (longer if using it on a scarf). She suggests a black warp as this helps the work to 'pop'. Bee uses black acrylic knitting yarn. You could choose any suitable yarn to suit your colour choice. The width of loom will determine the length of the piece done, as the wider it is, the more 'pockets' will be made to fill. SampleIt looms are good. Bee will bring 'wavy shuttles' for us to use. She will also hire out looms for the day for £10. (Need to know if anyone wants her to bring one)

For the weft, anything goes!!


Yarn (smooth, hairy, textured), fibre, ripped fabric strips, ribbons. Try to choose colours that compliment each other. Bee could bring yarn, she charges £2.50 for this if required and that includes a long needle to keep. Let Gill know if you want Bee to bring yarn in. You will also need hooks and big eyed needles eg. Latch hooks, rug hooks, crochet hooks, big eyed needles, long plastic needles could be useful. Scissors.

If you would like Bee to bring yarn for you please contact Gill ASAP. Also there may be room for one more on the workshop and if so also contact Gill.
