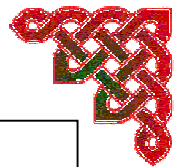
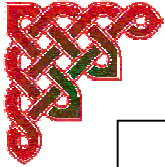

May D'Arcy spinning at Cilcain show last year, a lovely lady.

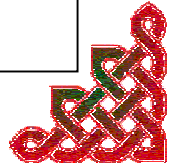
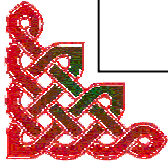
Joyce writes:

The Sky: On November 17th and 18th, the Earth passes close to the trails of comet debris from Comet Temple-Tuttle which produces the annual Leonid Meteor shower. Sadly, this year, the Moon will be nearly full in the same bit of sky, so our chances of seeing them will not be good. If you miss the Leonids, the next one is the Geminid Shower (Dec 13th).
